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CHAPTER-1

INTRODUCTION

Master Dayanand Memorial Educational Trust was established in October 2007. Under this trust Sanskaram College of Veterinary and Animal Science, Jhajjar (Haryana), has been established with broad vision, mission and mandate. The college is affiliated with Lala Lajpat Rai University of Veterinary and Animal Sciences (LUVAS), Hisar. The Institute follows all the rules and regulations set by Veterinary Council of India, and course curriculum for B.V.Sc & A.H and VLDD run according to latest VCI minimum standard of Veterinary Education (MSVE- 2016-17).

The college possesses **highly qualified and experienced faculty members of national and international repute**. The four storey building is available for teaching and extension education with well-equipped laboratories, smart class rooms and well facilitated residential accommodation for the college students and faculty. The institute have well equipped veterinary clinical complex which facilitate with veterinary diagnostic lab, clinical pathology lab, animal x-ray machine, USG machine and operation theatre for both large & small animals.

For the diversified development of the students college purposed various educational tours to different veterinary colleges, National Research Centers, Government farms, Animal farms, stud farms, dairy plants, slaughter houses, zoo and National parks in the different part of country.

Extracurricular activities like sports and cultural programme for all round growth and development of the scholar on roll will be integral part of ongoing academic activities of Sanskaram College of Veterinary and Animal Science (Sanskaram COVAS).

MEANING AND SCOPE OF THE PROSPECTUS

It is a brief compilation of information and not an exhaustive detail of all the regulations made by the competent authority in this regard. The provisions of the prospectus are in the shape of guidelines which are available to the candidates seeking admission and do not in any manner limit the power of any Competent Authority in making additional regulations regarding the admission of the candidates in either B.V.Sc. & A.H or VLDD course.

Admissions are made in accordance with the admission rules/guidelines issued by LUVAS University, Hisar. Since it is not possible to mention detailed procedure and guidelines in the prospectus, admission rules are to be read with the instructions issued/to be issued from time to time with the approval of the board of studies of college of veterinary sciences/competent authority. The candidates are advised to visit the university website regularly for the updates (www.sanskaramveterinarycollege.com).

LOCATION AND CLIMATE

Sanskaram College of Veterinary and Animal Science (SCOVAS) is situated at Jhajjar city of Haryana. Jhajjar is located 55 km west of Delhi NCR. The college is situated at Kheri Taluka, Patauda near the road connecting Rewari to Rohtak (NH- 352), Loharu to Meerut (NH-334B), Charkhi Dadri to Delhi and Gurgaon to Bhiwani.



The climate here is considered to be a local steppe climate. There is little rainfall throughout the year. In a year, the rainfall is 627 mm | 24.7 inch. June is the warmest month of the year. The temperature in June averages 33.5°C | 92.3°F. The lowest average temperatures in the year occur in December-January, when it is around 13.4°C | 56.1°F. The month with the highest relative humidity is August and the month with the lowest relative humidity is April. The month with the highest number of rainy days is August and the month with the lowest number of rainy days is November.

CHAPTER-2

FACILITIES AVAILABLE

LIBRARY

The college e-Library serves as the academic heart of the college to support teaching programmes, research activities and extension. It also advances the success and impact of the college community by providing access to information and recorded knowledge by investing in environment conducive to study, research and learning. It is situated on the second floor of main building measuring more than 3000 square feet area and it is divided into service areas, collections stall and reading hall which can accommodate 150 scholars at a time. The library house has nearly 2000 books of different disciplines, scientific journals, departmental manuals magazines,

Hindi and English newspapers etc. It is managed and operated by the librarians and supporting staff. The library facilitates with Xerox service at nominal rates, Wi-Fi, central computer lab and e-journals etc. The library has inviting ambiance and spaces for group study, quiet reading, study carrels for solo study and research.



CONFERENCE HALL

A full air-condition conference Hall in the College provides the right environment and ambiance for various programmes, seminars and conferences, lectures, board room-style meetings. The seating capacity is about 200 chairs with the ease of having a front stage for activities. The conference hall fully equipped with audio and video



aids provides appropriate environmental training to the students. Wi-Fi connection in the hall enables the guests and staff members to access the internet during the program.

AUDITORIUM

The college is having a huge indoor auditorium with a professionally-deployed acoustic system and a seating capacity of about 500 people. This auditorium has the immense pride of having hosted several National Level Seminar. The objective behind the auditorium is to enhance the quality of education. To make this possible, the auditorium offers facilities such as LCD projectors, screens for delivering lectures. It also provides ample opportunity for our staff and students to exhibit their talents in cultural activities.

GAMES AND SPORTS

The institute recognizes the importance of sportsman spirit and team effort for students. This can be learned in a congenial environment through sports and games. For



this, the Campus has adequate sports facilities and state-of-the-art infrastructure. A number of inter and intra college sports events can be organized throughout the year to enable the students to develop a spirit of healthy competition and team effort. The Campus has adequate sports infrastructure e.g. Cricket, Basketball, Volleyball, Football, Badminton, Table Tennis, Chess and several other Indoor and Outdoor games. VETERINARY CLINICAL COMPLEX

Department of Veterinary Clinical Complex serves the need of remedies of all animals including wild animals, diagnosis of diseases of animals, clinical teaching and various veterinary extension activities through its different units. Average 2,500 clinical cases of various animal species in medicine, gynecology, surgery and the pet animal section have been provided treatment and about 1,000 samples have been examined in diagnostic laboratory annually. Furthermore, VCC will providing clinical teaching programme to impart the need based practical training in animal health to the undergraduate students.



At Present following facilities are available under this department:

1. Out Patient Department (OPD) facilities for Veterinary Medicine, Gynaecology & Surgery.
2. Small animal radiography.
3. Small and Large animal abdominal and reproductive ultrasonography.
4. Small animal Electrocardiography.
5. Small animal nebulization.
6. Small animal & large animal soft & hard tissue surgery.
7. Small animal & large animal Artificial Insemination (AI).
8. All species Parasitological examinations of both stool & blood.
9. Routine haematological examinations of all species.
10. Routine urine analysis of all species.
11. Routine skin scrapping examination facilities.
12. Necropsy (post mortem examination) of all species.
13. Intensive Care Unit (ICU) for small and large animals.



AMBULATORY SERVICES

The Ambulatory Clinic serves animal farms within a 40 kilometer radius of Jhajjar. Our Animal Hospital clinicians offer a variety of on-the-farm services, from individual animal care to herd health. If you can't bring your animals to the hospital, or simply prefer not to, let us bring our exemplary care to you. Although most of our

ambulatory visits occur within 40 kilometer of Jhajjar district, we are happy to travel farther by special arrangement.

We offer a full range of ambulatory services, including:

- ✓ Routine herd health, including vaccinations, parasite control, pregnancy examinations, castration and dehorning
- ✓ Herd-level disease surveillance testing (Brucellosis, Johne's, Tuberculosis, Caseous lymphadenitis and more)
- ✓ Treatment of emergency medical issues
- ✓ Herd disease outbreak investigations
- ✓ Herd health planning to help improve animal health and efficiency

CLINICAL CAMPS AND FIELD VISIT

Clinical camps are a great option that can give valuable hands-on experience to the students. Our college will be offering several hands-on vet camps, including day camps for students to acquaint and interact with the actual field problems of livestock owners.



Veterinary Clinical and Animal Health camps are organized in almost all the districts of the state from time to time to educate farmers on different diseases and aspect of prevention and control of different diseases. In each camp 50 to 100 animals were diagnosed for their illnesses, treated and operated upon. Animal keepers were advised regarding proper care of their animals for good health and productivity. On an average 4-5 such camps were organized every month.



LIVESTOCK FARM COMPLEX (LFC)



Well functional livestock farm complex is available within the campus. Students & Teachers participating in animal management practice in large animal as well as in small animals like sheep, goats, pig and poultry at our college animal farm premises. Livestock Farm Complex, a constituent of Dairy, Buffalo, Sheep, Goat, Piggery, Poultry and fodder production units. The animal units are functioning with the objectives to serve as an instructional farm, to maintain elite flocks of murrah buffalo, cattle, sheep, goats, pigs, chicken, and turkeys. Scientific management, breeding, feeding and housing follows at LFC to improve the productive and reproductive performance of animals. The fodder unit is also functioning under this Department to serve as an instructional farm, to produce fodder for livestock feeding. The B.V.Sc. & AH, students will attend all the constituent units of LFC and be imparted hands-on training on various aspects



of livestock farming and fodder production.

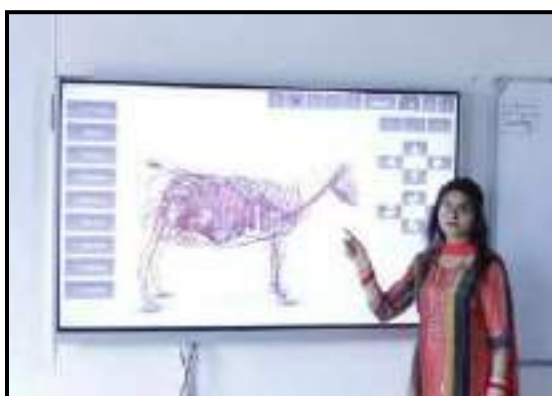
COMPUTER CELL/ARIS CELL

The college has a well-equipped (ARIS Cell). The Cell provides internet connectivity to different Departments of Colleges as well as hostels through LAN and wireless access points. This is useful for the retrieval of information and data from various sources on various aspects needed by students and



teachers. This facility not only helps students and teachers of the college but also the farmers and animal –owners as their problems are addressed by making use of the latest information in that field. Through the ARIS Cell students and teachers get direct and rapid access to the various online journals, especially through CERA made available by the Indian Council of Agriculture Research, New Delhi. There is a well-equipped computer laboratory in the ARIS Cell where students can access the internet, do computer-related work and can also retrieve information from various resources available online.

AUDIO-VISUAL SMART CLASSROOM



We are offering smart classrooms facilities for our students that will foster creativity and an interactive environment that would help in easy learning, bringing innovative ideas, more queries and more solutions. Consequently, there is broadening of

the domain of knowledge that a student acquires and encouragement in informal learning through this versatile solution.

WELL-EQUIPPED LABORATORIES



Livestock Production Management aims at increasing the productivity of animal and their products through appropriate farm management practices. This department has been started to impart teaching, and extension activities. An adequate open area for practical demonstration to the students is available at the farm complex. The facilities available at the animal farm are electronic dehorner, burdizzo castrator, tattooing and branding sets for dehorning, castration of animals and identification of animals, respectively.



Department of Veterinary Anatomy has the directive to make acquainted the students with the form and structure of various animal species and to facilitate them to learn the basic concepts and fundamentals of veterinary anatomy and histology that serves as the foundation for the



future sciences of different streams like Gynaecology, Surgery, etc. This department also deals with principles of embryogenesis and organogenesis during the development process. To fulfil these criteria, the department has a well-equipped gross anatomy demonstration hall as well as a dissection hall. The embalming room has the facility for short and long-term storage of dissected specimens and articulated and disarticulated skeletons of several livestock.



Department of Physiology and Biochemistry undertake studies on mammalian and avian haematology, climatology, and basic biochemical analysis. In addition to this, they

are actively involved in academic, institutional, and capacity-building activities of the college. The available facilities are Automatic Haematological analyzer, Spectrophotometer, Viscometer, Urinometer, Meteorological instruments (Maximum and Minimum thermometer, Wind vane, Flame Photometer, Paper Chromatography system, Fume hood, Blood Chemistry semi auto-analyzer, etc).

CHAPTER-3

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR ADMISSIONS

1. ELIGIBILITY AND REGISTRATION (B.V.Sc & A.H)

- i) The candidates under all categories must have passed in 10+2 examination and obtained a minimum of 50% marks (except SC category) in aggregate of English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology subjects from a “recognized/ approved Board of School Education having equivalences by Council of Boards of School Education (COBSE), New Delhi/CBSE/ICSE and also by Board of School Education Haryana, Bhiwani”. **As per Chief Secretary to Govt. of Haryana letter no. 22/129/ 2013-1GSIII dated 16.07.2014, the SC category candidates will be allowed a relaxation up to 5% of the requirement for General Category i.e. the SC candidates securing a minimum of 47.5% marks in aggregate of the four subjects mentioned above will be eligible to apply for admission.** No such relaxation will be applicable for management quota seats of Sanskaram Veterinary College and Animal Science, Kheri Taluka Patauda (Jhajjar).
- ii) The candidate must have attained or will attain the age of 17 years and the upper age limit for candidates of all categories (except SC and BC) is 25 years as on the day of registration. The upper age limit shall be relaxed by a period of 5 years for the candidates of SC and BC categories of Haryana State. No such relaxation in the upper age will be applicable for management quota seats of Sanskaram Veterinary College and Animal Science, Kheri Taluka Patauda Jhajjar.
- iii) The list of Boards/Universities, un-recognized/un-approved/not found equivalent by Board of School Education, Haryana /C.B.S.E./ICSE and Council of Boards of School Education, New Delhi. Later on, if any other Board is not found equivalent for 10th and/or 10+2, the certificate issued by such a board will be invalid and the candidates possessing such certificates will not be eligible for the admission. Inadvertently, if any such candidate is admitted, his/her admission shall be cancelled at any time by the Registrar besides disciplinary action as per rules.
- iv) In case result of the qualifying examination has been declared publicly but the certificate has not been issued by the concerned Board/University, such candidates shall have to

produce a certificate from the Head of the Institute last attended.

- v) The last date for submission of online duly filled admission form for all the seats of COVS, Hisar and Sanskaram Veterinary College and Animal Science, Kheri Taluka Patauda Jhajjar will be given on the website
- vi) The coloured 2.0" × 2.0" size photograph (**taken on or after 01-04-2021**) to be uploaded on the admission form should depict the name of candidate and date of taking photo and it should be without cap and dark glasses. If the 2.0" × 2.0" size photograph is old or with cap or dark glasses or disfigured, the admission form shall be rejected.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND REGISTRATION (VLDD)

- i) Admission forms for VLDD is separate. VLDD Diploma Entrance Test (VLDDDET-2021) is conducted by the LUVAS.
- ii) The candidates under all categories must have passed in 10+2 examination of any stream and the candidates under all categories must have passed matriculation/ 10th standard examination and obtained a minimum of 60 % marks (except for SC category) from a recognized/ approved board of school education having equivalence by Council of Boards of School Education (COBSE), New Delhi /CBSE/ICSE and also by Board of School Education Haryana, Bhiwani. As per Chief Secretary to Govt. of Haryana letter no. 22/129/2013- 1GSIII Dated 16.07.2014, the SC category candidates will be allowed a relaxation up to 5% of the requirement for General Category i.e. the SC candidates securing a minimum of 57 % marks in 10th standard examination. No such relaxation will be applicable for management quota seats of affiliated private colleges.
- iii) The candidate must have attained or will attain the age of 17 years as on 31st December, 2021. However, for the reserve categories (SC and BC), there will be relaxation of 5 years in the maximum age limit. No such relaxation will be applicable for management quota seats of affiliated private colleges.
- iv) In case, the result of the qualifying examination has been declared publicly but the certificate has not been issued by the concerned board/university, such candidates shall have to produce certificate from the Head of institute last attended.
- v) The recent coloured photograph of size 2.0'' x 2.0'' to be uploaded with the admission form should depict the name of candidate and date of taking photo. The focus needs to be

on face (80% face coverage, ears clearly visible, on white background). Photograph should not be with cap or goggles. • Spectacles are allowed, only, if being used regularly. • Polaroid and Computer-generated photos are not acceptable. The application of candidates who upload the computer generated 18 photographs or with any other specification not covered in these instructions will be rejected. Applications not filled in with these instructions or if the 2.0'' x 2.0'' size photograph is old or with cap or dark glasses or disfigured or with unclear photographs are liable to be rejected. Application without photographs shall be rejected.

- vi) Application processing and counselling fee will be refunded later, in due course of time and candidates are advised to reapply and pay admission fees again, with their photographs according to these instructions.
- vii) Candidates are advised to keep 6 to 8 passport size coloured photographs of the same photograph as uploaded with the application. Admit Card is to be downloaded by the candidate from the university website. After downloading the admit card, the candidate should affix a similar 4''X6'' size coloured photograph.
- viii) Candidates may note that if the photographs uploaded are found to be fabricated i.e. deshaped or seem to be hand-made or computer made, the application of the candidate will be rejected and the same would be considered as using Unfair Means and the candidate would be dealt with accordingly as per Rules and law.

3. NEET 2021 (B.V.Sc & A.H)

- a. All the candidates (except NRI and Foreign Nationals) seeking admission to B.V.Sc. & A.H. programme of COVS, Hisar as well as Sanskaram COVAS, Kheri Taluka Patauda Jhajjar must appear in the NEET-2021 (UG).
- b. Applicants who have appeared in 10+2 or equivalent examination with required subjects (even if result is yet to be declared) may also apply, however, such candidates will be considered for admission on merit of NEET-2021 (UG) basis provided they fulfill the eligibility conditions as given under Rule 1 of this Chapter and production of all the original documents at the time of document verification. In case of two or more candidates scoring same marks in the NEET 2021, the merit would be decided on the basis of percentage of aggregate marks obtained in the subjects of English, Physics, Chemistry and

Biology/Biotechnology of 10+2 examination. If still, there is a tie then the candidate senior in age will be considered higher in the merit.

4. ENTRANCE TEST (VLDD-2021) FOR VLDD ONLY

All the VLDD candidates shall have to appear in VLDD-2021, on 28.11.2021 as updated on university website. Applicants who have appeared in 10+2 or equivalent examination (even if result is yet to be declared) may also appear in VLDD-2021, however, such candidates will be considered for admission on merit basis of VLDD-2021 provided they fulfil the eligibility conditions and on production of all the original documents (coloured Photostat of documents) will not be accepted at the time of document verification.

5 COUNSELLING-CUM-ADMISSION (B.V.Sc. & A.H)

- a. The competent authority reserves the right to reject any admission form for reasons to be recorded in writing.
- b. The allocation of seats will be through online counselling and the details will be available on university website.
- c. The admissions on all the seats of B.V.Sc. & A.H. programme at COVS, Hisar as well as Sanskaram college of Veterinary and Animal Science (Sanskaram COVAS), Kheri Taluka Patauda Jhajjar will be made as per the merit list to be prepared on the basis of marks obtained by the candidates in the NEET-2021 (UG). **All the state quota seats of B.V.Sc. & A.H programme at COVS, Hisar as well as at Sanskaram COVAS, Kheri Taluka Patauda Jhajjar, are only for Haryana resident candidates**, while for admission to the management quota seats of **Sanskaram COVAS, Kheri Taluka Patauda Jhajjar** the candidates from all over India including Haryana will be eligible, subject to fulfillment of eligibility conditions.
- d. All the state quota seats of COVS, Hisar as well as of Sanskaram COVAS, Kheri Taluka Patauda Jhajjar will be filled up by roster system as indicated in the letter received from time to time from Govt. of Haryana.
- e. Admission on Management Quota Seats of Sanskaram COVAS will be made on the basis of All India Merit List of NEET-2021 (UG) for which the candidates from all over the country including Haryana will be eligible.

- f. The candidates, who have been allotted seats as per the NEET-2021 (UG) merit list in the respective category, are to report for document verification and other admission formalities as per the schedule to be uploaded on the university website, in the **Auditorium of College of Veterinary Sciences, LUVAS, Hisar, failing which they will have no claim for admission. No separate letter in this connection shall be issued.**
- g. The candidates shall have to pay fees and other charges there and then, otherwise the seat will be declared vacant. If any candidate after completion of admission formalities does not deposit the required fee, his/her candidature will be cancelled and he/she will not be eligible for subsequent counselling(s). Also if any candidate remains absent at the time of document verification, fee deposition and medical examination, he/she will not be considered in the subsequent counseling(s) even if he / she is higher in merit. Further, if a candidate refuses to accept admission on his/her turn, he shall lose his/her right of admission. He / she will not be considered for admission on the subsequent counselling even if he / she is higher in merit.
- h. **The candidates are required to bring all the original documents, two recently taken photos and two sets of self-attested photocopies of documents etc. as per rule 3.k of this chapter, at the time of document verification, failing which they shall be refused admission.** The original documents of the admitted candidates shall be retained by Registrar's office and temporarily provided to the candidate on a written request for a week or up to one day before the subsequent counselling, whichever is earlier and if not returned back by the date committed, admission of that candidate shall stand automatically cancelled. These documents will be returned to the candidates after the completion of verification process.
- i. After deposition of the fees and other charges, the candidates shall get themselves medically examined from Senior Medical Officer at the University Hospital, CCS HAU, Hisar, submit medical certificate on the same day in the o/o Dean, COVS and complete the registration on the same day. The fees deposited by the candidate, who is found medically unfit, shall be refunded and his/her admission shall automatically stand cancelled. The admission of those candidates, who fail to complete any of the admission formalities, shall stand cancelled and on the request of the candidate the dues paid shall be refunded as per rules.

- j. **The completion of admission process involves the followings:**
- i. Verification and submission of all the original documents along with self-attested photocopies as indicated under the rule 3.k at the time of document verification.
 - ii. Deposition of fees and other charges.
 - iii. Medical Examination.
- k. Original and two sets of self-attested photocopies of the following documents are required to be deposited with the Admission Committee at the time of document verification and **failure to produce any of the original documents shall make the candidate ineligible for the admission.**
- i. Matric Certificate with Date of Birth and father's/mother's name and 10+2 certificate from Board of School Education, Haryana/C.B.S.E./ I.C.S.E./ any other Board considered approved/equivalent as member by COBSE, New Delhi. If any certificate is found fake or not equivalent by any of the above Boards, admission will be cancelled and legal action initiated. In case result has been declared publicly but the certificate of qualifying examination has not been issued by the concerned Board/University, such candidates shall have to produce a certificate from the Head of the institute last attended.
 - ii. Admit Card issued by the concerned Education Board for 10+2 final examinations.
 - iii. Haryana Resident Certificate, if required.
 - iv. Character Certificate from the institute last attended.
 - v. The applicants who have passed the qualifying examination earlier and if there is a gap of more than one year from the date of declaration of result of the previous examination (other than the pursuit of studies in an institution/college) shall give a self-undertaking regarding their non-enrolment in any institution. Similarly, the applicants who have passed the qualifying examination as private candidates will also have to submit undertaking in this regard.
 - vi. Relevant certificate if the benefit of reserved category is being claimed. The candidates claiming reservation under BC categories are required to submit the Backward Class Certificate issued by the competent authority.
 - vii. Aadhar Card
 - viii. The candidate must bring at the time of counselling two recently taken coloured

2.0"×2.0" size photographs as uploaded on admission form.

- l. The applications of those candidates who are not admitted even during the cut off date shall be destroyed after six months barring those related to the court cases, if any.
- m. The record of the entrance test/counselling shall be destroyed after six months of last counselling/cut-off date except that related to any pending court case.

6. COUNSELLING-CUM-ADMISSION (VLDD)

- a. The competent authority reserves the right to reject any admission form for reasons to be recorded in writing.
- b. The allocation of seats will be through online counselling and details will be available on university website. State and management quota seats in affiliated private colleges will be filled up by the IPVS, LUVAS. All the admission orders in constituent and affiliated private colleges/institutions will be made by admission committee for admissions to diploma courses, LUVAS, Hisar.
- c. The admission on all seats of VLDD will be made as per the merit list to be prepared on the basis of marks obtained by the candidates in VLDDDET-2021 to be conducted by the LUVAS. Admission to the diploma course is open for male, female and transgender candidates. The Diploma course is open to Haryana residents only.
- d. All the seats at IPVS, LUVAS and State Quota seats of affiliated private colleges will be filled up by the roster system as indicated in letter no. 22/10/2013-1GSIII dated 15.07.2014 of Govt. of Haryana and instruction(s) received from time to time from Govt. of Haryana except for the management quota seats.
- e. Admission on management quota seats of affiliated private colleges will be made by the Admission Committee for admissions to diploma courses, LUVAS on the basis of combined merit list of VLDDDET-2021.
- f. The candidates, who have been allotted seats as per the merit list in the respective category, are to report for document verification and other admission formalities as per the schedule to be uploaded on the university website in the Auditorium of College of Veterinary Sciences, LUVAS, Hisar, failing which they will have no claim for admission. No separate letter in this connection shall be issued.
- g. The candidate shall have to pay government fixed fees and university Registration-cum-two years' examination fees there and then as NEFT or a single Demand Draft payable to

Director, IPVS, LUVAS, Hisar, otherwise the seat will be declared vacant. If any candidate after completion of admission formalities does not deposit the required fees, his/her candidature will be cancelled and he/she will not be eligible for subsequent counselling(s). Also if any candidate remains absent at the time of document verification, fee deposition and medical examination, he/she will not be considered in the subsequent counselling(s) even if he/she is higher in merit. Further, if a candidate refuses to accept admission on his/her turn, he shall lose his/her right of admission. He/she will not be considered for admission on the subsequent counselling even if he/she is higher in merit.

- h. Balance fees, charges, hostel funds, dues, etc., which are institute specific are to be paid at the college campus where finally admitted, after availing sliding of college admissions in affiliated private colleges and after issue of final admission order by the admission committee at the end of all counselling.
- i. The candidate is required to bring all the original documents (coloured photostat of documents will not be accepted), two recently taken photos and two sets of self-attested photocopies of documents, etc. at the time of document verification at COVS LUVAS, Hisar, failing which he/she shall be refused admission. The original documents of the candidates admitted to these Diploma courses shall be retained by the office of the Director, IPVS Hisar so as to get these verified from the Board/University/Office concerned after admission of the students. These documents will be returned to the candidates after completion of verification process. The original documents may be temporarily provided to the candidate on written request for a week or up to one day before the subsequent counselling, whichever is earlier, and if not returned back by the date committed, admission of that candidate shall stand automatically cancelled.
- j. The admission committee for admission to diploma courses will be as under: -
 1. Director IPVS, LUVAS, Hisar- Chairman
 2. One Faculty member to be nominated by Dean COVS, LUVAS, Hisar for VLDD
 3. One Professor to be nominated by The Vice-Chancellor- Member
- k. After deposition of the government-fixed fees and university registration-cum- two years' examination fees, the candidates shall get themselves medically examined from senior medical officer in the University at Hisar, submit medical certificate on the same day in the committee room of Dean COVS, LUVAS, Hisar. The fees deposited by the candidate,

who is found medically unfit, shall be refunded and his/her admission shall automatically stand cancelled. The admission of those candidates who fail to complete any of the admission formalities shall stand cancelled and on the request of the candidate the dues paid shall be refunded as per policy/Rules. Balance charges/hostel funds, etc., which are institution specific will be paid by the candidate at affiliated private institute, where finally admitted after completion of all scheduled counselling and sliding.

1. The completion of admission process involves the followings the verification and submission of all the original documents along with self-attested photocopies at the time of counselling/document verification at IPVS, Hisar.

Similarly, the applicants who have passed the qualifying examination as private candidates will also have to submit the undertaking in this regard.
- vii) Two coloured photographs of size 2" x 2", which should be the same as uploaded on the online admission form.
- viii) Copy of Aadhar card
- xi) Copy of the admit card of 10th class and 10+2 class issued by the concerned education board.
