Theme: "Colours of India"

1. Madhubani Fish: Draw a big fish on A4 sheet. Divide it with lines. Fill patterns like dots, lines, and flowers inside. Use black sketch pen for outline + bright poster colours to fill.
2. Torn Paper Collage: Make a "Rainy Day" scene on A4 sheet. Tear bits of blue, grey, and green paper from old magazines. Paste to make clouds, rain, trees, and umbrella.
3. Clay Fruit Basket: Make 3 fruits - apple, banana, grapes - using clay or atta dough. Let them dry. Paint with poster colours. Keep in a small box.
4. Best Out of Waste: Make a wall hanging using 3 old CDs. Join with wool/string. Decorate CDs with mirrors, buttons, or paint.
